SELF-DECLARATION

To Whom It May Concern,

Self-Declaration of Devotion to the Holistic Ministry of Nature, made on

I hereby declare my sincere devotion to the Holistic Ministry of Nature, as a Holy BEING (Idealist), affirming my commitment to living under Natural Law and the Biological Laws of Nature, guided by the Bible.

As a Holy BEING (Idealist), I embody Balance, Eternal Faith, Idealism, Nature, and Guardianship, and the following principles as central to my faith:

- Belief in God as the Creator of all things, who formed the universe and sustains it through divine providence, as stated in Scripture: *"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth"* (Genesis 1:1)
- Alignment with Natural and Universal Laws, including principles of balance, cycles, and interconnectedness inherent in God's Creation, as expressed in Scripture: *"There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens: a time to be born and a time to die, a time to plant and a time to uproot."* (Ecclesiastes 3:1-2)
- Connection to all through consciousness where all are united and equal, as one: *"For we were all baptized by one Spirit so as to form one body—whether Jews or Gentiles, slave or free—and we were all given the one Spirit to drink."* (1 Corinthians 12:13)
- Nature as the primary place of worship, where gatherings occur to attune to natural energies and rhythms: *"The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of His hands"* (Psalm 19:1).
- Affirmation of human freedom and stewardship under God's sovereignty, emphasizing trust in divine providence over reliance on systems that may restrict individual liberty or commerce in ways that conflict with the natural order, as supported by Scripture: *"It also forced all people, great and small, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a mark on their right hands or on their foreheads, so that they could not buy or sell unless they had the mark"* (Revelation 13:16-17)
- Reverence for the sanctity of the body as God's temple, promoting natural health practices in alignment with the biological laws of nature and divine order, and respecting individual conscience in decisions affecting personal health, as inspired by Scripture: *"Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God?"* (1 Corinthians 6:19) and *"Just as a body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ."* (1 Corinthians: 12:12)
- Commitment to only consuming animals in their natural state, free from artificial interventions and raised in alignment with nature, to honour the divine order of Creation and maintain the purity of God's provision, as affirmed: *"Everything that lives and moves about will be food for you. Just as I gave you the green plants, I now give you everything,"* (Genesis 9:3) and *"He makes grass grow for the cattle, and plants for people to cultivate—bringing forth food from the earth."* (Psalm 104:14)
- Reverence for God's provision of natural foods and medicines in their unprocessed form, including seed-bearing plants and herbs, as gifts for sustenance and healing, as confirmed: *"Then God said, 'I give you every seed-bearing plant on the face of the whole earth and every tree that has fruit with seed in it. They will be yours for food.'" (Genesis 1:29)*

- **Balance:** Living in harmony with God's creation, embracing principles of balance, cycles, and interconnectedness, as affirmed by Ecclesiastes 3:1-2: *"There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens: a time to be born and a time to die, a time to plant and a time to uproot,"* Proverbs 16:11: *"Honest scales and balances belong to the Lord; all the weights in the bag are of his making,"* and 1 Corinthians 12:12-13: *"Just as a body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ. For we were all baptized by one Spirit so as to form one body—whether Jews or Gentiles, slave or free—and we were all given the one Spirit to drink."*
- **Eternal faith:** Belief in God as the Creator and the eternal nature of faith, as per Scripture: *"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth,"* (Genesis 1:1) and: *"Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever."* (Hebrews 13:8)
- **Idealism:** Pursuit of God's divine vision for life aligned with nature, per Romans 1:20, Philippians 4:8, and John 10:10: *"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full."* This includes practices inspired by Christian and indigenous principles, such as reciprocity with the land and honoring ancestral wisdom through memory, per Hebrews 13:7: *"Remember your leaders, who spoke the word of God to you. Consider the outcome of their way of life and imitate their faith."*
- **Nature:** Nature reflects God in profound ways, serving as a mirror to His divine attributes, with sacred geometry evident in natural patterns as God's 'fingerprint', echoed in the Bible: *"For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities—His eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse."* (Romans 1:20)
- **Guardianship:** Commitment to stewardship through indigenous living, honouring humanity's Biblical mandate to care for Creation, as per Scripture: *"The Lord God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work it and take care of it."* (Genesis 2:15)

My belief in the biological laws of nature compels me to make health and stewardship choices for myself and all creation, including animals under my care, guided by individual conscience and trust in God's design for natural balance. I choose natural remedies over vaccinations for myself and any animals in my care, reflecting my faith in the God-given capacity for balance in all living beings, as supported by the scriptures above. These choices are expressions of my Christian faith, not medical claims, and are made in accordance with the Ministry Charity's trust deed, which respects individual conscience in decisions affecting personal health in accordance with Christian principles and UK laws that are demonstrably justified in accordance with human rights principles.

I respectfully assert my right to these choices under Article 9 of the European Convention on Human Rights, which protects freedom of thought, conscience, and religion, where no UK law demonstrably justified in accordance with human rights principles mandates otherwise.

The Ministry Charity does not promote medical claims but supports my right to make faith-based decisions, ensuring no harm to others or the public interest. I am prepared to provide further evidence of my sincerely held beliefs, including participation in the Charity's worship, workshops, or stewardship activities, to substantiate this declaration.

This declaration is made in good faith to affirm my beliefs and practices as a Holy BEING and Idealist of the Holistic Ministry of Nature. I respectfully request that my commitment to these beliefs be recognized in matters where my faith may inform my decisions or actions.
